N-umerous Life Changes

But some of them were men from Cyprus and Cyrene, who, when they had come to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists, preaching the Lord Jesus. **Acts 11:20 NKJV**

And the hand of the Lord was with them, and <u>a great number believed and turned to the Lord</u>. Acts 11:21 NKJV

Then news of these things came to the ears of the church in Jerusalem, and they sent out Barnabas to go as far as Antioch. Acts 11:22 NKJV

When he came and had seen the grace of God, he was glad, and encouraged them all that with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord. **Acts 11:23 NKJV**

For he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And <u>a great many people were added to the Lord</u>. Acts 11:24 NKJV

Then Barnabas departed for Tarsus to seek Saul. Acts 11:25 NKJV

And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and <u>taught a great many people</u>. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch. **Acts 11:26 NKJV**
