**What did Paul & Barnabas experience for the Gospel?
(Acts 13:1-49)**

So when the Jews went out of the synagogue, the Gentiles begged that these words might be preached to them the next Sabbath. **Acts 13:42 NKJV**

Now when the congregation had broken up, many of the Jews and devout proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God. **Acts 13:43 NKJV**

On the next Sabbath, almost the whole city came together to hear the word of God. **Acts 13:44 NKJV**

Then Jews from Antioch and Iconium came there; and having persuaded the multitudes, they stoned Paul *and* dragged *him* out of the city, supposing him to be dead. **Acts 14:19 NKJV**

However, when the disciples gathered around him, he rose up and went into the city. And the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe. **Acts 14:20 NKJV**

And when they had preached the gospel to that city and made many disciples, they returned to Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch, **Acts 14:21 NKJV**

strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting *them* to continue in the faith, and *saying*, "We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God." **Acts 14:22 NKJV**

So when they had appointed elders in every church, and prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord in whom they had believed. **Acts 14:23 NKJV**

This month we will be taking another look at the creation story but focusing on how God made people. He made us each in His image and uniquely special.

Memory Verse: God made me. Genesis 1:27-28 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Made Me with Hands and Feet

Parent Connect: Hang today's craft somewhere where your kid will see it throughout the week. Intentionally point it out this week and remind your kid that "God made them with hands and feet and God made them special."



This month we will be learning about the people that Jesus sent to start the early church! We'll learn that we have the same mission as them, to share Jesus with everyone!

Memory Verse: For you are to be his witness, telling everyone what you have seen and heard. What are you waiting for? Acts 22:15-16a

Heart of the Lesson: Share Jesus: It's Our Mission for Life – Acts 13

Parent Connect: Look at today's craft with your kid. Say: "How can this little Jesus remind us to share Jesus with our friends, family, neighbors, and around the world?" then remind your kid that "Sharing Jesus is our mission for life."



When Jesus left He gave His followers a mission to pass on the mission. However, He also promised to send a Helper - the Holy Spirit. With the power of the Holy Spirit, these early followers changed their world. That same Spirit is alive in us followers. Jesus wants to use us through the power of the Holy Spirit to change our world. What are you waiting for?

Memory Verse: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

Heart of the Lesson: We are called to be a part of the team to church plant – Acts 13-14

Parent Connect: Talk to your kids about the 6 roles we play in church planting (welcomer, goer, sender, mobilizer, and prayer) Which one has God called you to? Put action to what role God has called you to and get plugged in to fulfill your calling.
