A THANKSGIVING LESSON

3-week Christmas series means 3 opportunities for kids to be transformed into detective agents and discover "Who Missed It: Cracking the Case of Christmas." We will be examining the case files of Christmas found in Luke chapter 2 and Matthew chapters 1 & 2. Each week a suspect will be revealed as the person who missed out on celebrating's Christ's birth because they were too wrapped up in unbelief, busy-ness, or selfishness.

Heart of the Lesson: Thank God! - Luke 17:11-19

Parent Connect: As Thanksgiving passes, create a gratitude jar. Gather a jar, some colorful paper, and markers or crayons. Have your child write down all the things they're thankful for on small pieces of paper. Then, fold the papers and put them in the jar. Help them focus on specific things they're thankful for. Instead of just saying "I'm thankful for my family," encourage them to

name specific things they love about their family members. At meals or when the family is together, get the gratitude jar out and read a couple of the things that they are thankful for.

Make gratitude a regular practice. Don't just talk about gratitude on Thanksgiving. Encourage your kids to think about the
things they're grateful for every day.
