**Are you growing in really knowing Jesus through the power of his resurrection?**

**The risen Jesus wants to make Himself known to you - and through you.**

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**Jesus makes Himself known in our walk**

Now behold, two of them were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was seven miles from Jerusalem. Luke 24:13 NKJV

And they talked together of all these things which had happened. Luke 24:14 NKJV

So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them. Luke 24:15 NKJV

But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him. Luke 24:16 NKJV

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### **Jesus makes Himself known in Scripture**

And He said to them, “What kind of conversation *is* this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?” Luke 24:17 NKJV

Then the one whose name was Cleopas answered and said to Him, “Are You the only stranger in Jerusalem, and have You not known the things which happened there in these days?” Luke 24:18 NKJV

And He said to them, “What things?” Luke 24:19 NKJV

Then He said to them, “O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! Luke 24:25 NKJV

Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?” Luke 24:26 NKJV

And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. Luke 24:27 NKJV

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### **Jesus makes Himself known in relationship**

Then they drew near to the village where they were going, and He indicated that He would have gone farther. Luke 24:28 NKJV

But they constrained Him, saying, “Abide with us, for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent.” And He went in to stay with them. Luke 24:29 NKJV

Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke *it*, and gave it to them. Luke 24:30 NKJV

Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight. Luke 24:31 NKJV

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### **Jesus makes Himself known through our witness**

And they said to one another, “Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?” Luke 24:32 NKJV

So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven and those *who were* with them gathered together, Luke 24:33 NKJV

saying, "The Lord is risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" Luke 24:34 NKJV

And they told about the things that had happened on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of bread. Luke 24:35 NKJV

Memory Verse: Jesus is Alive Mark 16:6 b

Heart of the Lesson: We Can Tell Others That Jesus is Alive

Parent Connect: Take a moment today to review with your toddler what we have been learning this month. Use today's coloring sheet to review with your toddler. We wrote the story out on the back of the sheet if you prefer to read it with your toddler. Help your toddler say, "Jesus is alive!"



In This series we will learn about Jesus' teachings, his miracles, leading up to his death and resurrection. Through this series, we will learn each story shows us how Jesus loves us and how Jesus is the perfect example of how we should love others.

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His faithful love endures forever." Psalm 118:1

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Came to Save Us! | Matthew 21:1-17

Parent Connect: Today the kids learned about the big celebration that was Palm Sunday as Jesus entered the city and went to the temple. Go on a walk with your kid and either use your craft or find big leaves and act out the story with the waving of the Palm branches



In this series, we will use the movie GOAT to show your kids several ways that Jesus is really the true G.O.A.T.

Memory Verse: "He isn't here. He is risen from the dead!" Luke 24:6

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus shows us that He is the true GOAT by His willingness to die for us | Luke 23:33-35

Parent Connect:

Read: Luke 24:13-35

Talk: Jesus walks with us even when we don't notice. How can we get better at noticing He is with us?

Do: Take a short walk and talk to Jesus as you go.

# ALIVE

Knowing Jesus means that we know about his death, resurrection and know that He is alive today. Our series 'Alive!' will use interactive elements each week to help walk us through what Jesus' last days on earth were like: from his last meal at Passover, to the darkness He faced on the cross, to our sins being covered by the blood of Jesus. We will end the series on Easter with Jesus appearing to the apostles and, encourage students to share that Jesus is Alive!

Memory Verse: "He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what he told you back in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that he would rise again on the third day." Luke 24:6-7

Jesus proved that He is alive - Luke 24:13-35

Parent Connect: Draw with a white crayon on white paper (Jesus is Alive), then let your student paint over with watercolor to reveal the hidden message, symbolizing how Jesus revealed Himself to the disciples.
