What was Jesus' childhood like?

And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him. Luke 2:40 NKJV

His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. Luke 2:41 NKJV

And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast. Luke 2:42 NKJV


When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it; Luke 2:43 NKJV

but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. Luke 2:44 NKJV

So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him. Luke 2:45 NKJV

Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. Luke 2:46 NKJV

And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers. Luke 2:47 NKJV

So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, “Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously.” Luke 2:48 NKJV

And He said to them, “Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father’s business?” Luke 2:49 NKJV

But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them. Luke 2:50 NKJV

Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart. Luke 2:51 NKJV

And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men. Luke 2:52 NKJV

Is this not the carpenter’s son? Is not His mother called Mary? And His brothers James, Joses, Simon, and Judas? Matthew 13:55 NKJV

Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?” So they were offended at Him. Mark 6:3 NKJV
