## **Leprosy**

Leprosy (AKA Hansen's disease) is a bacterial infection which damages the nerves. People lose extremities when they don't notice their wounds. Leprosy is contagious.

## **Are you experiencing the second miracle?**

---

Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee.  
Luke 17:11 NKJV

Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. Luke  
17:12 NKJV

And they lifted up *their* voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" Luke 17:13 NKJV

So when He saw *them*, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. Luke 17:14 NKJV

And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well." Luke 17:19 NKJV

---

When a man has on the skin of his body a swelling, a scab, or a bright spot, and it becomes on the skin of his body like a leprous sore, then he shall be brought to Aaron the priest or to one of his sons the priests. Leviticus 13:2 NKJV

Now the leper on whom the sore is, his clothes shall be torn and his head bare; and he shall cover his mustache, and cry, 'Unclean! Unclean!' Leviticus 13:45 NKJV

He shall be unclean. All the days he has the sore he shall be unclean. He is unclean, and he shall dwell alone; his dwelling shall be outside the camp. Leviticus 13:46 NKJV

This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought to the priest. Leviticus 14:2 NKJV

### **Leprosy (physically) was a picture of sin (spiritually)**

---

And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, Luke 17:15 NKJV

and fell down on *his* face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. Luke 17:16 NKJV

So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where *are* the nine? Luke 17:17 NKJV

Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" Luke 17:18 NKJV

And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well." Luke 17:19 NKJV

### **Healing (physically) was a picture of salvation (spiritually)**

---

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-19 NKJV

Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning. James 1:16-17 NKJV

Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men! Psalm 107:8, 15, 21, 31 NKJV

It is good to give thanks to the LORD, And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High; To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness every night, Psalm 92:1-2 NKJV

Amazing grace, oh, how sweet the sound  
That saved a wretch like me  
I once was lost, but now am found  
Was blind, but now I see

Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; Colossians 4:2 NKJV

Heart of the Lesson: God Watches Over Us Because He Loves Us

Parent Connect: Play flashlight hide and seek as a family. Let the person seeking use a flashlight find the hiders. When you're done playing say: Can God see us when we're hiding? Who watches over us day and night? God watches over us!

Heart of the Lesson: Love Others | Luke 10:25-37

Parent Connect: Today we learned the story of The Good Samaritan! We learned how the Good Samaritan chose to love others and help the hurt man. Make your own "Good Samaritan bag"- fill it with bandages, a few dollars and cards inviting people to church. Keep it in your car or kid's bag and use it when you see someone who is hurt, in need or sad!



In this series, we will help kids learn to pray by contrasting real prayer with the Wizard of Oz story.

Memory Verse: Father may your name be kept holy. May your Kingdom come soon. Luke 11:2

Heart of the Lesson: Get alone to pray | Luke 5:16

Parent Connect:

Read: Luke 17:11-19

Talk: Only one man came back to thank Jesus, even though he had answered their prayers. Why is being thankful important? What is something you can thank God for today?

Do: Add a "thankful" section to your prayer board/book. Add things each person wants to thank Jesus for. Bonus: Listen to "I Thank God" by Maverick City

# THE LORD'S PRAYER

As we welcome our new 5th graders into G56 we will not only introduce how we Connect, Grow and Go in G56, but we will also be following along with the Adults as we walk through The Lord's Prayer as written by Luke. We will go through the prayer verse by verse, learning about the example Jesus gives, how it applies to our lives and how we can pray. Students will also learn how to implement and practice the practical tips that Jesus teaches us in the book of Luke on how we can pray.

Memory Verse: **“Luke 11:2-4 He said to them, “When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation.”**

Heart of the Lesson: God gives us what we need. Luke 11: 3,11-13

Parent Connect: Make a collage of things that you need (i.e. toothbrush, bed, clothes, food, shelter, transportation) and put them on a poster where you eat or spend time together as a family. Thank God for providing what you need.
