Memory Verse: "Jesus Loves Us." John 3:16 (Adapted for Toddlers)

Parent Connect: Take today's lesson deeper with your toddler at home! Sing this song to the tune of "Three Blind Mice." Climb up the tree. (Make climbing motions.) Climb up the tree. (Make climbing motions.) Who do you see? (Shield your eyes and look around.) Who do you see? (Shield your eyes and look around.) Jesus is standing below the tree. (Point to the ground.) Jesus loves you, and he loves me. (Point to your kid; then point to yourself) Jesus loves everyone we see (Shield your eyes and look around.) Climb down the tree (Make climbing motions.)

**Parent Connect:** Today we learned about the faith of a Roman solider. Take time with your kid and talk about some ways we put our faith into Jesus!
