## Do you identify (first & foremost) as a child of God?

In this series, we'll be learning that "God Sees Us". God sees us in our good times and our bad. This month we'll be looking at the story of Jonah and talking about how God could see Jonah even when he ran away. God loves us. God sees us.

Memory Verse: "God sees us." Job 31:4 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: We're Thankful That God Sees Us

**Parent Connect:** Read the back of today's coloring sheet out loud to your toddler then watch this video to hear the rest of the story of Jonah.



In this series kids will learn about the rebuilding of nations after the great flood - starting with a promise to Abram to give him many kids. In each lesson we learn how God has called us to obey and follow. In doing so, God also will always keep His promises!

Memory Verse: "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

Heart of the Lesson: God Gave Jacob a Big Family - Jacob's Big Family - Genesis 28-29

**Parent Connect:** Today we learned about how God gave Jacob a big family! Make a family tree chart of your family, draw a picture of each person – include friends and neighbors in your chart, too!



As kids go back to school there are many things we want to remind them. In this series, Grace Kids School Survival Guide, we will learn how we are Christ-image bearers, equipped with the Armor of God, and to live to glorify Him.

**Memory Verse:** "Put on your new nature, and be renewed as you learn to know your Creator and become like him." Colossians 3:10

Heart of the Lesson: Work hard in all that you do.

**Parent Connect:** Joy comes in serving God. Encourage your kids to think of ways they can serve others through their work, such as helping a sibling with homework or cleaning up a neighbor's yard. Remind them that even small tasks can be done with excellence and joy as an act of worship. People will know we follow Jesus by the way we live. How are we living currently?



We have been sent to share Jesus with others. In this series, we are going to learn practical tools that will help us share the good news of Jesus with people around us.

**Memory Verse:** "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23

Heart of the Lesson: Go and tell others - Mark 5:1-20, Romans 10:13-14, Matthew 28:19-20

**Parent Connect:** In this final lesson, the focus will be on the call to share Jesus with others. Encourage your student to consider practical ways they can share the Good News with their friends and peers. Discuss any opportunities they may have had or ways they can be intentional in spreading God's love. Pray together, asking God to provide courage and wisdom as they go and tell others about Jesus.
