In this series, we learn that God keeps us safe, because we have a relationship with Him! We follow the story of Noah and discover together that God keeps us safe because He loves us, just like he loved Noah.

Memory Verse: "God keeps us safe." Psalm 4:8 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Keeps us Safe Because He Loves Us

**Parent Connect:** Today we learned about how God instructed Noah to build and ark and even though it rained for many days, Noah was safe on the ark. Play in a water sensory bin or the bathtub with your toddler, and talk about why God kept Noah safe in the water with his Ark.



In this series, we will learn how God is always there and God will protect us! Following the life of Moses, from a baby floating down the Nile all the way through Moses' miracle parting the Red Sea, God protected him!

Memory Verse: "But when I am afraid, I will put my trust in You." Psalm 56:3

Heart of the Lesson: Exodus 3-4

**Parent Connect:** Today we learned how God speaks to us! God spoke to Moses with a burning bush! God called out 'Moses, Moses!' from the burning bush and Moses listened. Put the puzzle craft together with your kid. Talk about how Moses heard God speak from the burning bush.



What does it mean to follow Jesus? How do we follow Jesus? In this series we will look at how Jesus lived to see how He spent His life and how his disciples lived out what He said.

Memory Verse: "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me." John 10:27

Heart of the Lesson: Followers of Jesus have a Good Shepherd (1 Samuel 17:34-37, John 10:26-27)

**Parent Connect:** Explore the shepherd metaphor further. Talk about how a shepherd cares for and protects his sheep, even in challenging situations, as seen in 1 Samuel 17:34-37. Discuss how Jesus, in John 10:26-27, is described as the Good Shepherd. What does it mean for us to be His sheep?
