Are you walking in the Spirit or the flesh?

I. The Battle (v.16-18)

I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. **Galatians 5:16**For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. **Galatians 5:17**But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. **Galatians 5:18**

We learn to walk in the Spirit like we learn to walk

II. The Opponents (v.19-23)

Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,

envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told

you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians

5:21

Adultery. Fornication. Uncleanness. Lewdness.

Idolatry. Sorcery.

Hatred. Contentions. Jealousies. Outbursts of Wrath.

Selfish Ambitions. Dissensions. Heresies. Envy. Murder.

Drunkenness. Revelries. And the like.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, Galatians

5:22

gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. Galatians 5:23

Love. Joy. Peace.

Longsuffering. Kindness. Goodness.

Faithfulness. Gentleness. Self-Control.
