The message of Jesus is for the world

For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." **Romans 10:12-13 NKJV**

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen. **Matthew 28:19-20 NKJV**

God calls us to share the message of Jesus with the world

How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? **Romans 10:14 NKJV**

And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!" **Romans 10:15 NKJV**

But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. **Romans 10:16-17 NKJV**

But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: "Their sound has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." **Romans 10:18 NKJV**

Memory Verse: "God made families." Genesis 1:26a (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: I'm Happy That God Made Families

Parent Connect: Look through pictures of your family with your toddler and ask them "Who made our family?" (God). Tell them how happy and thankful you are that God made each member of your family. Help them think of ways their family makes them happy.



In this series, we will learn how God is always there and God will protect us! Following the life of Moses, from a baby floating down the Nile all the way through Moses' miracle parting the Red Sea, God protected him!

Memory Verse: "But when I am afraid, I will put my trust in You." Psalm 56:3

Heart of the Lesson: Exodus 1:22-2:10

Parent Connect: Today we learned how God protects us and how God protected little baby Moses as he traveled down the Nile River. Moses traveled in a basket down the river, not by boat or canoe! Talk to your kiddos about other ways people can travel! Boats, trains, cars, bus, plane, etc!



When Jesus comes to live in your heart, it changes you. His love lights a fire inside that we can't contain. His fire is contagious. It wants to grow and burn brighter and brighter. In this series, we will discover what it looks like to be on fire for God and how we can share this powerful love in our neighborhoods to the ends of the earth.

Memory Verse: His word burns in my heart like a fire. It's like a fire in my bones! I am worn out trying to hold it in! I can't do it!" Jeremiah 20:9b

Heart of the Lesson: On Fire For The World - Luke 10:2; I Timothy 2:1; Mark 16:15b

Parent Connect: During a time when you have your family together, write down all the countries you can name. Then pick the one you know the least about and look them up. What is their culture like? How many people know Jesus? Then go to visitgracechurch.com/missiontrips pray about going on a mission trip, and pray for all the people going on a trip next year.
