Heart of the Lesson: I'm Glad God Keeps Us Safe

Parent Connect: Today we learned about the gladness we feel that God keeps us safe. Sit around the dinner table and have each family member give an idea of how God keeps them safe and why they are happy about it.



In this series, we will learn about Moses following the Exodus and all the challenges he and God's people faced. From wondering in the desert, to God giving Moses the Ten Commandments, and wrapping up building the tabernacle.

Heart of the Lesson: God Provides | Exodus 15:22-17:7

Parent Connect: Today we learned about how God provided food to Moses and God's people. The food was Manna (bread), quail and water. Talk to your kids during dinner about the different foods that they are about to eat. Pray with your kids and thank God for providing the food at your dinner table.
