Jesus referred to Adam & Eve as real

But from the beginning of the creation, God *'made them male and female.'* **Mark 10:6 NKJV**

'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, **Mark 10:7 NKJV**

and the two shall become one flesh'; so then they are no longer two, but one flesh. **Mark 10:8 NKJV**

Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate." **Mark 10:9 NKJV**

The Fall (v.1-6) – How People Chose Sin over God – Nothing's Changed – 3 Questions

Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?’”

Genesis 3:1 NKJV

And the woman said to the serpent, “We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; **Genesis 3:2 NKJV**

but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, ‘You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.’” **Genesis 3:3 NKJV**

Then the serpent said to the woman, “You will not surely die. **Genesis 3:4 NKJV**

For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.” **Genesis 3:5 NKJV**

So when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make *one* wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. **Genesis 3:6 NKJV**

The Fall was about people becoming their own God

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned— **Romans 5:12 NKJV**

The Consequences (v.7-8, 12-13) – What Sin Does to Us – Nothing’s Changed – Destructive

Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. **Genesis 3:7 NKJV**

And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden. **Genesis 3:8 NKJV**

Then the man said, “The woman whom You gave *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate.” **Genesis 3:12 NKJV**

And the Lord God said to the woman, “What *is* this you have done?” The woman said, “The serpent deceived me, and I ate.” **Genesis 3:13 NKJV**

Sin kills what God made good in our lives

And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. **Matthew 24:12 NKJV**

What God Did (v.9, 15, 21) – Nothing’s Changed – All About Jesus – Q, Prophecy, Sacrifice

Then the Lord God called to Adam and said to him, “Where *are* you?” **Genesis 3:9 NKJV**

And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.” **Genesis 3:15 NKJV**

Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made tunics of skin, and clothed them. **Genesis 3:21 NKJV**

Jesus came to sacrifice Himself for our sins

For as by one man’s disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man’s obedience many will be made righteous. **Romans 5:19 NKJV**

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Helps Sick People, Because He Loves Them

Parent Engagement: Say: **Giving flowers to someone who is sick makes that person feel better as a way to spread Jesus' love. It's important to remember that Jesus helps sick people and that Jesus loves us. Jesus is the best friend we could ever have. And if we believe in him, we will live with him in heaven someday.** Help your toddler find someone who is sick to give their flower coloring sheet to to help them feel better.
