

Promises vs. Law (Galatians 3:16-29) - Freedom May 14, 2023

Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ. **Galatians 3:16 NKJV**

And this I say that the law, which was four hundred and thirty years later, cannot annul the covenant that was confirmed before by God in Christ, that it should make the promise of no effect. **Galatians** 3:17 NKJV

For if the inheritance is of the law, it is no longer of promise; but God gave it to Abraham by promise. **Galatians 3:18 NKJV**

The law has not changed God's promise

Is the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! For if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly righteousness would have been by the law. **Galatians 3:21 NKJV**

But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. **Galatians 3:22 NKJV**

But before faith came, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed. **Galatians 3:23 NKJV**

Therefore, the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. **Galatians 3:24 NKJV**

But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. Galatians 3:25 NKJV

God had a purpose for the law

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:26 NKJV

For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Galatians 3:27 NKJV

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. **Galatians 3:28 NKJV**

And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. **Galatians** 3:29 NKJV

Through Christ the promise is yours
