that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, Philippians 3:10 NKJV

Are you growing in really knowing Jesus?

When the world chooses violence, Jesus chooses peace

And while He was still speaking, behold, a multitude; and he who was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them and drew near to Jesus to kiss Him. Luke 22:47 NKJV

But Jesus said to him, “Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?” Luke 22:48 NKJV

When those around Him saw what was going to happen, they said to Him, “Lord, shall we strike with the sword?” Luke 22:49 NKJV

And one of them struck the servant of the high priest and cut off his right ear. Luke 22:50 NKJV

But Jesus answered and said, "Permit even this." And He touched his ear and healed him. Luke 22:51 NKJV

Then Jesus said to the chief priests, captains of the temple, and the elders who had come to Him, "Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs? Luke 22:52 NKJV

When I was with you daily in the temple, you did not try to seize Me. But this is your hour, and the power of darkness." Luke 22:53 NKJV

When the world breaks their word, Jesus stays true

Having arrested Him, they led Him and brought Him into the high priest's house. But Peter followed at a distance. Luke 22:54 NKJV

Now when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the courtyard and sat down together, Peter sat among them. Luke 22:55 NKJV

And a certain servant girl, seeing him as he sat by the fire, looked intently at him and said, "This man was also with Him." Luke 22:56 NKJV

But he denied Him, saying, "Woman, I do not know Him." Luke 22:57 NKJV

And after a little while another saw him and said, "You also are of them." But Peter said, "Man, I am not!" Luke 22:58 NKJV

Then after about an hour had passed, another confidently affirmed, saying, "Surely this fellow also was with Him, for he is a Galilean." Luke 22:59 NKJV

But Peter said, "Man, I do not know what you are saying!" Immediately, while he was still speaking, the rooster crowed. Luke 22:60 NKJV

And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had said to him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times." Luke 22:61 NKJV

So Peter went out and wept bitterly. Luke 22:62 NKJV

When the world questions Jesus, Jesus knows He's the Son of God

Now the men who held Jesus mocked Him and beat Him. Luke 22:63 NKJV

And having blindfolded Him, they struck Him on the face and asked Him, saying, "Prophecy! Who is the one who struck You?" Luke 22:64 NKJV

And many other things they blasphemously spoke against Him. Luke 22:65 NKJV

As soon as it was day, the elders of the people, both chief priests and scribes, came together and led Him into their council, saying, Luke 22:66 NKJV

"If You are the Christ, tell us." But He said to them, "If I tell you, you will by no means believe. Luke 22:67 NKJV

And if I also ask you, you will by no means answer Me or let Me go. Luke 22:68 NKJV

Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God." Luke 22:69 NKJV

Then they all said, "Are You then the Son of God?" So He said to them, "You rightly say that I am." Luke 22:70 NKJV

And they said, "What further testimony do we need? For we have heard it ourselves from His own mouth." Luke 22:71 NKJV

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This series we are learning that Jesus is alive! We will learn the story of Jesus' death and resurrection and how He is alive today!

Memory Verse: Jesus is Alive Mark 16:6 b

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is Alive

Parent Connect: In today's lesson we learned that a butterfly can remind us that Jesus is alive. Ask your toddler why we made a butterfly and cocoon in class today? Discuss how the cocoon reminds us of when Jesus died and was in the tomb. The butterfly reminds us that Jesus came out of the tomb and was alive! Practice yelling, "Jesus is Alive!" together while playing with today's butterfly craft.



In This series we will learn about Jesus' teachings, his miracles, leading up to his death and resurrection. Through this series, we will learn each story shows us how Jesus loves us and how Jesus is the perfect example of how we should love others.

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His faithful love endures forever." Psalm 118:1

Heart of the Lesson: Love Others | Luke 10:25-37

Parent Connect: Today we learned a Good Samaritan who helped a hurt man. The Good Samaritan bandaged the man's wound. Make a "Good Samaritan Bandage" snack with your kid this week. You will need: A graham cracker, white icing for the gauze and red icing for the blood.



For seven weeks, we will help our kids not only learn more facts about Jesus and His ministry but also imagine what it might have been like if they were on the journey with Jesus. How would they have responded? What emotions might they have felt?

Memory Verse: The disciples were terrified and amazed. "Who is this man?" they asked each other. "When he gives a command, even the wind and waves obey him!" Luke 8:25b

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Reveals His Glory | Luke 9:28-36

Parent Connect:

Read: Luke 22:47-71

Talk: When the crowd came to arrest Jesus, how did he show love even though difficult things were happening?

How do you think the disciples felt when Jesus healed the ear?

Do: Act out this scene together. (vs 47 - 51)

ALIVE

Knowing Jesus means that we know about his death, resurrection and know that He is alive today. Our series 'Alive!' will use interactive elements each week to help walk us through what Jesus' last days on earth were like: from his last meal at Passover, to the darkness He faced on the cross, to our sins being covered by the blood of Jesus. We will end the series on Easter with Jesus appearing to the apostles and, encourage students to share that Jesus is Alive!

Memory Verse: "He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what he told you back in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that he would rise again on the third day." Luke 24:6-7

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus knows what it's like to be betrayed - Luke 22: 47-71

Parent Connection: We all know what it feels like to be betrayed, Jesus knows too. This week in G56 we learned that Jesus knows what it's like to be betrayed. This is a great opportunity to talk with your student about a time they felt betrayed and how they should handle it in a Christlike manner (like praying for someone who hurts you). You can also share your own experience of betrayal and share if you handled betrayal the way Jesus would.
