Doing good restores others to Christ

Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who [are] spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted. **Galatians 6:1**

Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. Galatians 6:2

For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. **Galatians 6:3**Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all. **1 Thessalonians 5:14**

God's warning - Thinking we're better than others.

And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the plank in your own eye? **Luke 6:41**

Or how can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove the speck that is in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the plank that is in your own eye? Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye **Luke 6:42**

Doing good invests in things of the Spirit

But let each one examine his own work, and then he will have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another. **Galatians 6:4**

For each one shall bear his own load. Galatians 6:5

Let him who is taught the word share in all good things with him who teaches. **Galatians 6:6**Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. **Galatians 6:7**For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. **Galatians 6:8**
