Heart of the Lesson: What is God Like? - John 1:18, Colossians 1:15, Revelation 4:11, 1 John 4:8, Genesis 1:27

Parent Engagement Question: We know that Jesus showed us what God is like. What do you like the most about Jesus? God is love. Talk about how you can be more like God this week by being more loving to others. God is worthy of praise. How can you praise Him this week?
