This month, we are learning about Zacchaeus and how Jesus loved him, and that Jesus loves us too!

Memory Verse: "Jesus Loves Us." John 3:16 (Adapted for Toddlers)

Parent Connect: We've been learning that Jesus loves everyone! We learned that we need to make sure that we tell people that Jesus loves them, too. We can use the story of Zacchaeus to tell people about Jesus! Say: Why is it important to tell other people that Jesus loves everyone? (So they can know Jesus; so they can be happy; so they can go to heaven.) You made a beautiful Valentine's card at church today. lets think of someone you can give this card to. Who is someone that you would like to share the love of Jesus with? Help your kid deliver the valentine card to someone that can use some extra love today.



In this series, we will see how those who followed Jesus had faith! Jesus performed miracles and those who were needing the miracles had faith that Jesus would help! Let's learn from these bible stories on how we can have faith and follow Jesus, too!

Memory Verse: Jesus looked at them and said, "With people, this is impossible. But with God, all things are possible. Matthew 19:26 (NirV)

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Heals Jairus' Daughter Matthew 9, Mark 5, Luke 8

Parent Connect: Today we learned how Jesus healed Jairus' daughter when she was very sick. Take time to pray with your kid about others you may know who are sick and need healing



What makes a Superhero, Super? SuperPowers! And Christians have something inside of them that makes them super! Spiritual Gifts! In this series we will discover that God gives them to us, they are unique and needed, and how we can use ours to serve God, His Church, and Others.

Heart of the Lesson: God made me unique and needed. Ephesians 2:10

Parent Connect: Talk to you kids about what their spiritual gifts may have. Discuss how they can use them. Then talk about the gifts they aren't strong in and think of people who have them and how they use them.

As we continue our 2024 theme of One Church this series focuses in on God giving each of us spiritual gifts. We will explore why he made us unique, what spiritual gifts are, and how we can use our gifts to serve him.
