## **When You See the Savior You Speak About Him**

So when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their *own* city, Nazareth. **Luke 2:39 NKJV**

And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him. **Luke 2:40 NKJV**

Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. **2 Corinthians 3:16 NKJV**

Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty. **2 Corinthians 3:17 NKJV**
