JESUS CAME AS A BABY THE CHRISTMAS STORY

Why do you suppose that God announced the birth of Jesus to the shepherds first? It is likely because these common folk would be more likely to receive him more wholeheartedly than anyone else. Perhaps they were the ones that needed Jesus the most. Like the shepherds needed Jesus, so does your toddler. They too, can rejoice with the angels that God sent his Son, Jesus into the world to live as an example for us and to die for our sins.

Memory Verse: Jesus was born. (adapted from Luke 2:6)

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Was Born in a Stable

Parent Engagement Question: Let your toddler help you set up your family nativity set. Talk about each figure as you place it in the nativity saving baby Jesus for last. Let your toddler be the one to place baby Jesus in the nativity.
