How did Jesus view death? (John 14:1-6)

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. John 14:1 NKJV

In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not *so,* I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. John 14:2 NKJV

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also. John 14:3 NKJV

And where I go you know, and the way you know." John 14:4 NKJV

Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?" John 14:5 NKJV

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. John 14:6 NKJV

And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— John 14:16 NKJV

In this series, we will be learning the story of the Good Samaritan. We will talk about how God cares for us all the time and how we can care for others.

Memory Verse: Jesus Cares. 1 Peter 5:7 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: We Are Thankful that Jesus Cares

Parent Connect: Read the story on the back of your kid's coloring sheet to him/her sometime today. Talk about ways that you know that Jesus cares for you and your family.



In this series, we will look at the life of Jesus, his ministry, and how he fulfills all of the Old Testament prophecies that we've been learning about all year in our One Story Plan.

Memory Verse: "John saw Jesus coming towards him and said, 'Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" John 1:29

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Is The Way To Heaven - John 13:1-3 and John 14

Parent Connect: Today we learned that Jesus is the only way to get to Heaven. We showed the kids that they can't get their on their own. The cross on their activity sheet shows them that they need Jesus to get to God in Heaven. Have your kid explain the cross activity sheet to you. When they finish, tell them that they just shared the Gospel with you. Encourage your kid to use the activity sheet to share the Gospel with someone else they know.



In this series, we will show how Jesus is the fulfillment of the promises we have been reading about all year in the Old Testament. His birth, ministry, death, and resurrection were all foretold. He is the Passover lamb, the Good Shepherd, the perfect prophet, priest, king, and Messiah.

Memory Verse: "I am the Alpha and the Omega—the beginning and the end," says the Lord God. "I am the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come—the Almighty One." Revelation 1:18

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is coming back - John 1, 14, Revelation 19, 22

Parent Connect: How can your family remember, or look forward to, Jesus' return? How should that motivate you to tell others about Him?





The One Story of the Bible all points to Jesus. Jesus came to earth with a mission, and, long story short, it is to seek and save the lost. Through this 7-week series, we'll explore how Jesus lived His mission, and how He calls us to take part of it.

Memory Verse: For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost. Luke 19:10

Heart of the Lesson: Response Stations

Parent Connect: What did you learn about Jesus during this series? What did you learn about your relationship with Him? Write it down on a notecard and put it somewhere you will be reminded of it!



While the whole Bible is about Jesus, it's time to study the Gospels, where we get to learn about Jesus' ministry on Earth to people like you and me! Just like Jesus called people to follow Him and share Him with others, He calls us to follow Him and share Him with others!

Memory Verse: John 10:27 (NIRV) "My sheep listen to my voice. I know them, and they follow me."
