**STUDY NOTES**

**Titus 2:11 NKJV** - For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,

**Romans 1:20 NKJV** - For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,

**Titus 2:12 NKJV** - teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

# GOD HELPS US

THE BATTLE OF JERICO



Read Joshua 6:1-20. From a human perspective, the battle of Jericho must have seemed crazy—both to the residents of the city and to the Israelites marching around the city. Joshua was not just confident of God's help, he was confident of the outcome. Confidence in God's help is closely connected to our belief that God is able to accomplish his will no matter how difficult the task. Sometimes God stretches our faith by accomplishing great things in unexpected ways.

**Memory Verse:** God helps us. Genesis 21:22b (adapted for toddlers)

**Heart of the Lesson:** God Helps Us When We Trust Him

**Parent Engagement:** Use empty boxes or blocks to build a wall. March around it with your toddler 7 times. On the 7th time around be sure to yell and blow your imaginary trumpets. When your toddler isn't looking, gently knock the wall over like God knocked the wall over in our story today. Remind your toddler that "God helps us!"

**Memory Verse:** But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. James 1:22a

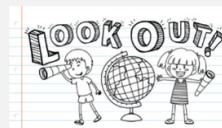
**Heart of the Lesson:** Listen for God's Voice - Samuel hears God 1 Samuel 3

# DO SOMETHING

AN OUTREACH SERIES

That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!” Romans 10:14-15

**Heart of the Lesson:** What do Hindus believe and how can I share the gospel with Hindu people? - 1 Timothy 2:5, Deuteronomy 4:35

**Parent Engagement:** Discuss what makes Christianity different from Muslim beliefs. How can you share the gospel with Muslim people?
