## **What's the theme of Titus?**

Paul, a bondservant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which accords with godliness, **Titus 1:1 NKJV**

in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began, **Titus 1:2 NKJV**

but has in due time manifested His word through preaching, which was committed to me according to the commandment of God our Savior; **Titus 1:3 NKJV**

To Titus, a true son in our common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior. **Titus 1:4 NKJV**

## GOD MAKES THINGS GROW

1 CORINTHIANS 3:7



In this series, we will learn about the ways God makes living things in our wonderful world grow—things such as animals, plants, and people. Your toddler will have the opportunity to touch, smell, hear, taste, and see things that grow to reinforce the point that *God makes things grow*.

**Memory Verse:** God makes things grow. 1 Corinthians 3:7 (adapted for toddlers)

**Heart of the Lesson:** God Makes People Grow

**Parent Engagement:** Set out some clothes and accessories of various sizes. Grab some clothes that fit your toddler as well as clothes that you know will be too small and even some of your own clothes that will be too big. Let your toddler try the clothes on. Ask questions like, “Why don’t these clothes fit?” Explain that God helps them grow bigger. Remind your toddler that *God makes people grow*.

**Memory Verse:** Give thanks to the God of heaven. His faithful love endures forever. Psalm 136:26

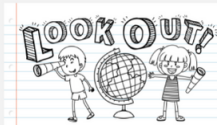
**Heart of the Lesson:** Do What’s Right - VeggieTale: Daniel - Daniel 6

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# DO SOMETHING

AN OUTREACH SERIES



In this series, we will be learning about how to engage unreached people groups around the world with the gospel. The students will begin their time in small groups to research information and discover different ways that they can Do Something to be involved in local and global outreach initiatives. The students will end each week in Large Group to present what they discovered.

**Memory Verse:** But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, "How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!" Romans 10:14-15

**Heart of the Lesson:** What do Animists believe and how can I share the gospel with Animist peoples? - Isaiah 43:10

**Parent Engagement:** Discuss what makes Christianity different from Animist beliefs. How can you share the gospel with Animist peoples?
