Who is Jesus? (Matthew 16:13-17)

When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?" Matthew 16:13 NKJV

So they said, "Some say John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." Matthew 16:14 NKJV

He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Matthew 16:15 NKJV

Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Matthew 16:16 NKJV

Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed *this* to you, but My Father who is in heaven. Matthew 16:17 NKJV

Jesus showed us knowing Him is God's gift // Among the many gifts from God

1 Corinthians 2:7-16 // All spiritual truth is revealed to us by the Holy Spirit

What is the church? (Matthew 16:18-20)

And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. Matthew 16:18 NKJV

And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." Matthew 16:19 NKJV

Then He commanded His disciples that they should tell no one that He was Jesus the Christ. Matthew 16:20 NKJV

Jesus showed us the church is Jesus' plan // The church is plan A. There is no plan B.

Ephesians 4:11-16 // Jesus reaches, connects, equips, mobilizes, & grows people in love through His church

Why did Jesus say that? (Matthew 16:21-23)

From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day. Matthew 16:21 NKJV

Then Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "Far be it from You, Lord; this shall not happen to You!" Matthew 16:22 NKJV

But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men." Matthew 16:23 NKJV

Jesus showed us human reasoning can oppose God // When we think through things without thinking about God; when our minds are a "God-free zone"

Romans 12-1-2 // God uses the Bible and the Holy Spirit to continually renew and transform our minds
