Then he came to Derbe and Lystra. And behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timothy, *the* son of a certain Jewish woman who believed, but his father was Greek. **Acts 16:1 NKJV**

He was well spoken of by the brethren who were at Lystra and Iconium. **Acts 16:2 NKJV**

Paul wanted to have him go on with him. And he took *him* and circumcised him because of the Jews who were in that region, for they all knew that his father was Greek. **Acts 16:3 NKJV**
