God Will Purify His People

“Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming,” Says the Lord of hosts. **Malachi 3:1 NKJV**

God ask His people to Return to Him


“For I *am* the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob. **Malachi 3:6 NKJV**

Jesus vs. The World



The world tells us a lot of things and if we aren't careful, it is easy to start listening to the world and acting like the world. The Bible tells us that God's kingdom is the opposite of the world and therefore the way we live should be different from the ways of this world. In this series, we are going to break down what Jesus tells us vs. what the World tells us. The victory is already won but you have to decide who you are going to let win in your life!

Memory Verse: Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect Romans 12:2

Heart of the Lesson: In God's Kingdom, Obeying Not Just Hearing - Matthew 7:24-27

Parent Engagement: Get a deck of cards. Try building a simple house on a table and on a blanket or bed (something soft or bumpy). Which one is more stable? See if your kids can tell you how that relates to the difference between hearing God's Word and actually doing it.

Parent Engagement: Have your student role-play how they would answer today's question if a friend asked them.
