#### Is Jesus on the throne of your heart?

Then all the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron and spoke, saying, "Indeed we *are* your bone and your flesh. **2 Samuel 5:1 NKJV** 

Also, in time past, when Saul was king over us, you were the one who led Israel out and brought them in; and the Lord said to you, 'You shall shepherd My people Israel, and be ruler over Israel.' " **2 Samuel 5:2 NKJV** 

Therefore all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron, and King David made a covenant with them at Hebron before the Lord. And they anointed David king over Israel. **2 Samuel 5:3 NKJV** 

David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years. 2 Samuel 5:4 NKJV

In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months, and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty-three years over all Israel and Judah. **2 Samuel 5:5 NKJV** 

Then David dwelt in the stronghold, and called it the City of David. And David built all around from the Millo and inward. **2 Samuel 5:9 NKJV** 

So David went on and became great, and the Lord God of hosts [armies] was with him. 2 Samuel 5:10 NKJV

### Are you letting God fight your battles?

Now when the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines went up to search for David. And David heard of it and went down to the stronghold. **2 Samuel 5:17 NKJV** 

The Philistines also went and deployed themselves in the Valley of Rephaim. 2 Samuel 5:18 NKJV

So David inquired of the Lord, saying, "Shall I go up against the Philistines? Will You deliver them into my hand?"... 2 Samuel 5:19a NKJV

...And the Lord said to David, "Go up, for I will doubtless deliver the Philistines into your hand." **2 Samuel 5:19b NKJV** 

So David went... 2 Samuel 5:20a NKJV

Then the Philistines went up once again and deployed themselves in the Valley of Rephaim. **2 Samuel 5:22 NKJV** 

So David inquired of the Lord... 2 Samuel 5:23a NKJV

..and He said, "You shall not go up; circle around behind them, and come upon them in front of the mulberry trees. **2 Samuel 5:23b NKJV** 

And it shall be, when you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the mulberry trees, then you shall advance quickly. For then the Lord will go out before you to strike the camp of the Philistines." **2 Samuel 5:24 NKJV** 

And David did so, as the Lord commanded him; and he drove back the Philistines from Geba as far as Gezer. **2 Samuel 5:25 NKJV** 

So David went to Baal Perazim, and David defeated them there; and he said, "The Lord has broken through my enemies before me, like a breakthrough of water." Therefore he called the name of that place Baal Perazim. **2 Samuel 5:20 NKJV** 

And it shall be, when you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the mulberry trees, then you shall advance quickly. For then the Lord will go out before you to strike the camp of the Philistines." **2 Samuel 5:24 NKJV**

This month we will be learning about how Israel wanted a king so they could be like everyone else. We will be learning about Israel's first king, Saul and how he wasn't following God. Then we will learn about Israel's second king, David and how he did have a heart like God and God was with him.

Memory Verse: "The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need." Psalm 23:1

Heart of the Lesson: Worship God - David Worships God - 2 Samuel 6

**Parent Connect:** Use today's activity sheet to put the events of David's life in order. What happened first, second, third, and fourth? David had a lot of reasons to worship God. Discuss a few reasons that your family has to worship God. Spend some time praying, singing, playing instruments, etc as a family worshiping God together.



For the next 5 weeks we will look at David's life to see what it looks like to follow God. David is known for being a man after God's heart. We want to be after God's heart too. Through this series we will learn what it means to be after God's heart and what happens to us when we know Him.

**Memory Verse:** "The Lord is my strength and shield. I trust him with all my heart. He helps me, and my heart is filled with joy. I burst out in songs of thanksgiving." Psalm 28:7

Heart of the Lesson: When you know God, you talk to him a lot - David's Battles - 2 Samuel 5

Parent Connect: Thumb wrestle each other. Talk about what battles you are facing. How can God help you?



We all want to feel like we are slaying in life! In this series, we are taking a look at the life of David and how he slayed because he chose to follow God and believe His promises.

**Memory Verse:** But God removed Saul and replaced him with David, a man about whom God said, 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart. He will do everything I want him to do.' "And it is one of King David's descendants, Jesus, who is God's promised Savior of Israel! Acts 13:22-23

Heart of the Lesson: Review Week - 1 Samuel 8-17

**Parent Connect:** Which story about Samuel, Saul, and David stuck out to you the most? Compare the different people you learned about and their attitudes towards God (Samuel, Saul, David, Goliath). What is your attitude towards God?



God gave Israel a good King after Saul: King David! David was a king after God's own heart. Just like God wanted David to follow Him, He wants us to follow Him too! We can learn from David's life what it looks like to be after God's own heart.

Memory Verse: Psalm 51:10 (NIRV) "Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me."
