Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; ***Romans 12:6 NKJV***

or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; ***Romans 12:7 NKJV***

he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness. ***Romans 12:8 NKJV***

### **H = Heart**

So I came to Jerusalem and was there three days. Then I arose in the night, I and a few men with me; I told no one what my God had put in my heart to do at Jerusalem... ***Nehemiah 2:11-12 NKJV***

### **A = Abilities**

Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. ***1 Corinthians 10:31 NKJV***

### **P = Personality**

This month, we are learning about Zacchaeus and how Jesus loved him, and that Jesus loves us too!

**Memory Verse:** "Jesus Loves Us." John 3:16 (Adapted for Toddlers)

**Parent Connect:** Discuss today's lesson with your kid at home by saying: Can you use the craft you made at church to tell me what you learned today at church? Allow verbal kids to retell the story helping as much as you need to. If your kid is not verbal yet, say things like, Can you point to Jesus? Can you point to Zacchaeus? Let's make Zacchaeus climb up the tree so he can see Jesus! (move the string so he will "climb" the tree Jesus said, "Zacchaeus come down. I'm eating at your house today!") (Move the string so Zacchaeus "climbs down" the tree) Say, Jesus loved Zacchaeus and he loves us, too!



In this series, we will see how those who followed Jesus had faith! Jesus performed miracles and those who were needing the miracles had faith that Jesus would help! Let's learn from these bible stories on how we can have faith and follow Jesus, too!

**Memory Verse:** Jesus looked at them and said, "With people, this is impossible. But with God, all things are possible. Matthew 19:26 (NirV)

**Heart of the Lesson:** Jesus Calls the Little Kids | Mark 10:13-1

**Parent Connect:** Today we learned how Jesus loves kids. He calls everyone to follow Him; grown-ups, kids, everyone! Show your kids what you looked like when you were a kid! Show other family members and friends, too!



What makes a Superhero, Super? SuperPowers! And Christians have something inside of them that makes them super! Spiritual Gifts! In this series we will discover that God gives them to us, they are unique and needed, and how we can use ours to serve God, His Church, and Others.

**Memory Verse:** "A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other." 1 Corinthians 12:7

**Heart of the Lesson:** God gives us superpowers. Exodus 31:1-6

**Parent Connect:** Talk about your favorite superheroes, what makes them super, and why you like them. God gives us superpowers in the form of spiritual gifts. They make us super, and we can make an impact for God using them.



As we continue our 2024 theme of One Church this series focuses in on God giving each of us spiritual gifts. We will explore why he made us unique, what spiritual gifts are, and how we can use our gifts to serve him.

**Memory Verse:** A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other. 1 Corinthians 12:7

**Heart of the Lesson:** God made me unique and needed – Psalm 139:13-17

**Parent Connect:** Grab a knit blanket, scarf, or anything knit you have at home and examine it. Talk about its intricacies and how God knit you together uniquely.
