# JESUS CAME AS A BABY THE CHRISTMAS STORY

Why do you suppose that God announced the birth of Jesus to the shepherds first? It is likely because these common folk would be more likely to receive him more wholeheartedly than anyone else. Perhaps they were the ones that needed Jesus the most. Like the shepherds needed Jesus, so does your toddler. They too, can rejoice with the angels that God sent his Son, Jesus into the world to live as an example for us and to die for our sins.

Memory Verse: Jesus was born. (adapted from Luke 2:6)

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Was Born on a Special Night

Parent Engagement Question: Find baby Jesus in your family nativity set. Let your toddler gently hold the baby Jesus figure.

Discuss why this baby is so important.

How do you think the people reacted when the shepherds told them what they had seen? Who first told you about Jesus? Who is someone you can tell about Jesus who doesn't know Him yet?
