Why do you suppose that God announced the birth of Jesus to the shepherds first? It is likely because these common folk would be more likely to receive him more wholeheartedly than anyone else. Perhaps they were the ones that needed Jesus the most. Like the shepherds needed Jesus, so does your toddler. They too, can rejoice with the angels that God sent his Son, Jesus into the world to live as an example for us and to die for our sins.

Memory Verse: Jesus was born. (adapted from Luke 2:6)

Heart of the Lesson: The Shepherds Came to Visit Jesus

Parent Engagement Question: Look at the shepherds in your family nativity set. Talk about the special job that shepherds had.

Discuss why you think they were the first to hear that baby Jesus had been born.
