Faith is following God when you don't know where you're going

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. - **Hebrews 11:8 NKJV**

For we walk by faith, not by sight. - 2 Corinthians 5:7 NKJV

...Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house... - Genesis 12:1 NKJV

...Lot went with him... - Genesis 12:4 NKJV

Faith is following God even though you're not perfect

JESUS HELPS SICK PEOPLE

JESUS HEALS THE MAN THAT COULDN'T WALK



This month we will be learning about a time when Jesus helped a sick man who couldn't walk. We'll be learning about how Jesus loves sick people and we can love them, too!

Memory Verse: Jesus helps us all. Matthew 11:28 (adapted for toddlers).

Heart of the Lesson: We Are Thankful That Jesus Loves Sick People

Parent Engagement: Look at your kid's coloring sheet from class. Read the story on the back to your toddler and say: The man in the Bible story didn't feel good when he couldn't walk. But he knew that <u>Jesus helps sick people</u>, and Jesus healed him. That made the man happy, and he thanked God right away. Lead your toddler in praying for sick people you might know.

HOW IT ALL STARTED



This year we will be walking through the Bible together as a church. This month we will take a look at the book of Genesis from Creation to Abraham and Isaac.

Heart of the Lesson: Follow God's Call - Abram's Call - Genesis 12:1-9, 15:1-6

Parent Engagement: Reread the story of Abram's call in a kid's Bible with your kid. Go outside at night in a dark place and look up at the stars. Remind your kid that the stars can remind us of God's promise and timing. Stare at the stars for a while and really think about how big of a promise this really was to Abram!

PART ONE OF OUR WALK THROUGH THE BIBLE

Heart of the Lesson: Abram's Call - Follow God's Call - Genesis 12, 15

Parent Engagement: Abram didn't know where God's promise was going to take him but he trusted God. Take your kids somewhere but don't tell them where you are going and if they ask questions tell them to trust you. Afterwards, remind them of the story of Abram trusting in God's promise for him.

GUESS WHO?

Heart of the Lesson: Who made a promise to Abram? - Genesis 12, 15

Parent Engagement: How did Abram trust God's promise to him? What other promises does God make in His Word? Look up promises of God. Then, write one on a sticky note and keep it somewhere where you will see it!
