*Jesus is the King of Kings (Mark 15:21-32) – Who Is This Man? – March 27-28, 2021*

## Jesus is the King of Kings

### King Jesus was crucified (Mark 15:21-32)

- Then they compelled a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, the father of Alexander and Rufus, as he was coming out of the country and passing by, to bear His cross. **Mark 15:21 NKJV**
- And they brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull. **Mark 15:22 NKJV**
- Then they gave Him wine mingled with myrrh to drink, but He did not take it. **Mark 15:23 NKJV**
- And when they crucified Him, they divided His garments, casting lots for them to determine what every man should take. **Mark 15:24 NKJV**
- Now it was the third hour, and they crucified Him. **Mark 15:25 NKJV**
- And the inscription of His accusation was written above: THE KING OF THE JEWS. **Mark 15:26 NKJV**
- With Him they also crucified two robbers, one on His right and the other on His left. **Mark 15:27 NKJV**
- So the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “And He was numbered with the transgressors.” **Mark 15:28 NKJV**
- And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads and saying, “Aha! You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, **Mark 15:29 NKJV**
- save Yourself, and come down from the cross!” **Mark 15:30 NKJV**
- Likewise the chief priests also, mocking among themselves with the scribes, said, “He saved others; Himself He cannot save. **Mark 15:31 NKJV**

- Let the Christ, the King of Israel, descend now from the cross, that we may see and believe.” Even those who were crucified with Him reviled Him. **Mark 15:32 NKJV**

### **King Jesus is the Son of God (Mark 15:33-39)**

- Now when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour.  
**Mark 15:33 NKJV**
- And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?” which is translated “My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?” **Mark 15:34 NKJV**
- Some of those who stood by, when they heard *that*, said, “Look, He is calling for Elijah!” **Mark 15:35 NKJV**
- Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered *it* to Him to drink, saying, “Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down.” **Mark 15:36 NKJV**
- And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last. **Mark 15:37 NKJV**
- Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. **Mark 15:38 NKJV**
- So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, “Truly this Man was the Son of God!” **Mark 15:39 NKJV**
