One Vision: Seeing as God Sees

Seeing Money as God Sees

For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Luke 12:34 NKJV

God owns everything you have

And you shall remember the LORD your God, for *it is* He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as *it is* this day. Deuteronomy 8:18 NKJV

"For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. Matthew 25:14 NKJV

And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey. Matthew 25:15 NKJV

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Memory Verse: ““God keeps us safe.” Psalm 4:8 (adapted for toddlers)”

Heart of the Lesson: God Keeps Us Safe and Protects Our Families

Parent Connect: Today we learned that God keeps us safe wherever we are. Build a fort with your toddler and discuss how God keeps us safe wherever we are, inside or outside our fort!



In this series, kids will learn that no matter what happens – whether we’re doing big things for God like Josiah, making mistakes like Jonah, feeling sad like the people of Jerusalem or standing strong like Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego- God is with us!

Memory Verse: “Be still and know that I am God. I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world.” Psalm 46:10

Heart of the Lesson: Daniel and His 3 Friends | Jeremiah 25:1-11, 2 Chronicles 36:17-21, Daniel 1

Parent Connect: This week, ask your kid about Good Choices versus Bad Choices. Is hitting a good choice or a bad choice? Is sharing a good choice or a bad choice? We learned this week how Daniel and his friends made good choices by honoring God even when it was hard. You can read about it in 2 Daniel 1:1-7!



Each and every one of us was created in the image of God with an inspired design from our creator. Our I.D. is what makes each of us unique and what makes all of us so wonderfully connected. Join us in this series as we explore our I.D. in Jesus as free, adopted, and loved creations in Christ.

Memory Verse: I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. Psalm 139:14

Heart of the Lesson: I Am Loved | Psalm 139

Parent Connect: We are fully loved by Jesus! Today we learned that Jesus loves us more than we can ever think or imagine. We learned that God was intentional with our design and even thought about our fingerprints when he was making us. Ask your kid what their fingerprints represent and talk about how God made each of us special because he loves us!

We are all uniquely created by God, and each follower of Jesus is given a unique set of spiritual gifts meant to be used for His glory. In this series, students will discover their identity in Jesus, explore the gifts God has given them, and learn how to use those gifts to serve Him and others. We will end the series with Response Stations to reinforce everything we learned!

Memory Verse: "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago." Ephesians 2:10

Heart of the Lesson: God made me unique and needed (Response Stations) – Psalm 139:13-17

Parent Connect: Grab a knit blanket, scarf, or anything knit you have at home and examine it. Talk about its intricacies and how God knit you together uniquely.
