Memory Verse: Jesus is our friend. John 15:15 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: We can be friends to Jesus

Parent Engagement: Show your toddler how to make a simple snack for your family. We recommend toast, spread with butter, and sprinkled with cinnamon sugar. Let your toddler make the snack as independently as they can and then give it to everyone in the family. "Jesus loves you and so do I" as they pass them out. This is a simple way for your toddler to be outward-focused.

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus was Baptized - Jesus' Baptism - Matthew 3

Parent Engagement: Use an action figure or doll to show your parents what you understand about baptism. Parents share your baptism story.
