Living in obedience shows we are forgiven by Jesus

My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. **1 John 2:1 NKJV**

And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world. **1** John 2:2 NKJV

...I write to you, little children, Because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake. **1 John 2:12 NKJV**

...I write to you, little children, Because you have known the Father. **1 John 2:13 NKJV**

Living in obedience shows we know Jesus

Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. **1 John 2:3 NKJV**

He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. **1 John 2:4 NKJV**

But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. **1 John 2:5 NKJV**

Is your obedience showing you know Jesus?

Living in obedience shows we look like Jesus

By this we know that we are in Him. He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked. **1 John 2:6 NKJV**

For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: **1 Peter 2:21 NKJV**

Memory Verse: The Bible is God's book. 2 Timothy 3:16 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Gave Us the Bible Because He Loves Us

Parent Connect: In our story today we learned about when King Josiah finds part of the Bible while he's cleaning out the temple. Retell the story to your toddler and then play a game of hide and seek with a Bible (2 Chronicles 34:1-35:19). Take turns hiding and finding it.



Memory Verse: Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever. Psalm 118:1

Heart of the Lesson: Remember to be Thankful - 10 Lepers - Luke 17:11-19

Parent Connect: Find times this week to count to 10 with your kid. Each time, remind your kid that our story this week was about 10 lepers that were very sick asking Jesus for help. Does your kid remember how many told Jesus thank you? Practice saying thank you prayers to Jesus this week.

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus warns us about being greedy - Luke 12:13-21

Parent Connect: The Bible teaches us to guard against greed and to be generous. Talk to your kids how they can guard against greed and as a family come up with one way you can, and will, be generous this week.
