Jesus unifies us as His children

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:26

For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Galatians 3:27

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. **Galatians 3:28**

And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. **Galatians 3:29**

Jesus frees us from slavery

Now I say that the heir, as long as he is a child, does not differ at all from a slave, though he is master of all, **Galatians 4:1**

but is under guardians and stewards until the time appointed by the father. Galatians 4:2

Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world. Galatians 4:3

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, **Galatians 4:4**

to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. Galatians 4:5

And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" **Galatians 4:6**

Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. **Galatians 4:7**

Memory Verse: "But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you." John 14:26

Heart of the Lesson: The Trinity – 1 Timothy 2:5

Parent Connect: Think of some different examples of things that have 3 parts in nature, such as water (water, ice, vapor), an apple (core, flesh, skin), or an egg (shell, yolk, white). These are not perfect examples but they help us remember God is 3 in 1.

Heart of the Lesson: Why do people worship idols? Psalm 115:4-8, Exodus 20:3, Mark 12:29-30, Romans 1:18-23

Parent Connect: What is giving you the most joy in your life? If it's anything other than Jesus, ask Him to help you get rid of your idols and turn to Him.
