

<u>Jesus is Wonderful (Isaiah 9:6-7) - November 27-28, 2021</u> Live Teaching

Isaiah 9:6 NKJV For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 9:7 NKJV Of the increase of *His* government and peace *There* will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

DAVID THANKS GOD THROUGH SONG

In this short two week series we will be learning about how David sang songs of thanksgiving to God. We will learn that we are never too young to start worshiping God. We will learn to thank God for the things and people that he has given us as well as for sending Jesus to be our forever friend.

Memory Verse: "We thank God." Psalm 107:1 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: We Thanks God for His Love

Parent Engagement: Intentionally pray with your toddler this week. Start teaching your toddler how to pray to God. Start with simple prayers of thanksgiving. Teach your toddler to be thankful for all that God has given them and slowly start working into other kinds of prayers.



Sometimes God asks us to do hard things. In this series we will learn three stories about people in the Bible that did really really hard things for God.

Memory Verse: Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. Isaiah 41:10a NLT

Heart of the Lesson: Esther Obeys God Even When It's Hard - Esther 1-10

Parent Engagement: As parents share some times when it was hard for you to obey. What did you do? Ask your kids how Esther obeyed God even though it was hard.



We will spend the next four weeks paralleling what the adults are learning in Isaiah 9:6. Each week we will focus on one of the names given to Jesus in this passage.

Memory Verse: For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is Wonderful

Parent Engagement: As a family, memorize Psalm 40:5. To start, have each person own a piece of the verse and go around the table/car and try to recite the verse.







We pray in Jesus' name. But do you know what that means? Join us as we follow what the adults are learning leading up to Christmas as we explore different names Jesus was given, and why they are important!

Heart of the Lesson: What does it mean that Jesus is Wonderful?

Parent Engagement: Draw some things that are wonderful. Discuss as a family, what are some ways that Jesus has been wonderful to you?
